Modern:

- You may wear any colour leotard, tights, dance shorts and tank top providing they are tight fitting to the body so that teachers may see the correct positioning
- All hair must be in a pony tail or a bun
- Bare Feet

Acro:

- You may wear any colour leotard, tights, dance shorts and tank top providing they are tight fitting to the body so that teachers may see the correct positioning
- All hair must be in a pony tail or a bun
- Bare Feet

Hip Hop:

- You may wear any colour leggings track pants and a shirt or tank top
- All hair must be in a pony tail
- Black slip on jazz shoes or black running shoes

Song & Dance:

- You may wear any colour leotard, tights, dance shorts and tank top providing they are tight fitting to the body so that teachers may see the correct positioning
- All hair must be in a pony tail or a bun
- Black slip on jazz shoes

As well, they get to kick off the competition season with a professional stage rehearsal and finish the season by performing their handwork in the year end recital!

Dancers will receive well-rounded training in all areas of dance with the opportunity to perform a variety of routines! Solos, duets & trios and of course group routines will be available to all members.

Requirements to Participate

Must take one hour of ballet and one hour of jazz technique per week.

Must commit to a minimum of two group routines.
